



Senior CASA requirements for first day of school

The following items are required for the first day of school. Please ensure that all items are labeled with your child's full name.

- Small blanket for sleeping cot. (blankets that touch the floor will be returned to you)
- Sleeping cot / crib sheet – size **28 inches x 52 inches** (This is a standard crib sheet size)
- 6 Kleenex boxes
- Hand sanitizer (at least 473 ml size)
- Water bottle – labelled with your child's full name
- Large back pack
- Face masks (a minimum of 2 masks) and a paper or ziploc bag to store masks if your child will be wearing a mask
- Extra sets of clothes (2 sets) including shirts, pants, underwear and socks. (Does not have to be school uniform). Accidents can happen, so please be prepared. Students must always have a change of clothes in their locker.
- Sunscreen and Sun hat. (Please ensure sunscreen is not expired). Students **MUST HAVE** these two items.
- Running shoes for outdoor activities. (**Velcro only, no laces please**)
- 2 packs of flushable wipes
- 2 packs of “Wet Ones” hand wipes
- Students with Anaphylaxis (life threatening allergies) must have 2 EpiPen's and an “Individual Action Plan” completed and signed. See campus supervisor.

Please label all items

Note: Students must be wearing the school uniform to attend school. Students without uniforms may not be permitted to class. Please label all uniform pieces and shoes. Teachers are not responsible for anything that is not labeled.



Supplies for Senior CASA

The following supplies are needed by all Senior CASA students. Please bring these supplies to school on the “Orientation Day” on August 25, 2023.

- 1 pack of white photocopy paper
 - 1 pack of Crayola construction paper
 - 1 pack of **Astrobrights Coloured Paper, "Bright" 5-Colour** (8 ½” x11” – 24 lb - 100 sheets) **and** 1 pack of **Astrobrights Coloured Cardstock, "Bright" 5-Colour Assortment** – 65lb 8.5”x11”
 - 1 binder – (2 inches)
 - 1 pack of pencils - Staedtler blue brand if possible (Norica) sharpened
 - 1 white (Staedtler brand) eraser
 - 1 (10.5 x 13 inch) mini whiteboard (dry erase board)
 - 24 Staedtler brand coloured pencils.
 - 3 EXERCISE BOOKS – 72 pages dotted interlined 23.1 x 18.1 cm. **Hilroy brand** (please make sure the full page is lined, NOT half the page) (**available at Walmart and other stationary stores**)
 - 1 pack of dry erase markers and eraser for whiteboard
 - 1 large hard plastic pencil case
 - 1 pair of safety scissors (left handed scissors if your child is left handed)
 - 6 UHU glue sticks
 - 2 pieces of Bristol board (blue and black)
 - 1 pack of big beads (Dollar store)
 - 1 pack of foam letters or shapes
 - 2 bottles of 225ml Elmers washable school glue
 - 1 box of Crayola washable project paint (box of 10 colours)
 - 1 art brush (1/2 inch wide brush only please)
 - 1 pack of white, lightweight, disposable, uncoated paper plates (Dollar store)
 - 1 plastic envelope with button and string tie closure **(9.75 x 13 inches only)**
- *Please bring all supplies in a box and label the box with your child’s full name.**

Uniform Requirements

The official school Uniform is mandatory for all students attending ABC Montessori except the Pre-CASA students. The school uniform must also be worn on every day and on field trips, unless otherwise suggested.

Articles of clothing other than official school uniforms will not be accepted in school. Please do not request for exceptions.

Boys

- a) White, collared InSchoolwear short-sleeved polo shirt with school logo, or
White, collared InSchoolwear long sleeve polo with school logo, or
White InSchoolwear turtleneck with school logo
- b) InSchoolwear burgundy cardigan with school logo
- c) InSchoolwear navy blue school pants
- d) Navy blue socks (any brand)
- e) Black soft non-marking soled dress Shoes (any brand)

Girls

- a) White, collared InSchoolwear short-sleeved Polo shirt with school logo, or
White, collared InSchoolwear long sleeve Polo with school logo, or
White InSchoolwear turtleneck with school logo
- b) InSchoolwear burgundy cardigan with school logo
- c) **FOR CASA STUDENTS:** InSchoolwear navy blue tunic or navy blue pants
- d) **FOR ELEMENTARY PREP AND ELEMENTARY STUDENTS:** InSchoolwear navy blue pants or school kilt
- e) Navy blue socks or stockings (any brand)
- f) Black soft non-marking soled dress Shoes (**can be purchased anywhere**)

GYM UNIFORM FOR ELEMENTARY PREPARATORY TO GRADE 5 ONLY:

- a) "ABC Montessori Athletics" white t-shirt with school logo
- b) InSchoolwear Blue track pants and sweatshirt with school logo or InSchoolwear blue shorts for warmer months, if needed
- c) White or blue socks (any brand)
- d) Running shoes (any brand – with velcro straps for younger students)

Health screening, Drop-Off and Pick-up Procedures

ABC Montessori - 285 Matheson CASA Campus

Step 1 – Daily Active screening for Households

Parents should observe their children for any signs of illness before coming to school and preferably take their temperatures.

Your child will not be able to attend school if they are ill. Please call or email school to advise symptoms. Our supervisor will advise when your child can return to school after illness.

Step 2 – School student illness screening

Please bring your child to the school entrance for illness screening and only leave once your child is admitted into the building. (The Ministry of Education requires us to observe every child for symptoms of illness before entering the classroom)

If your child has a temperature of 37.8 degrees or higher, or any other symptoms of ill health, you must take your child home immediately. Your child will not be able to attend school until advised that they can return.

School Drop-off times

Regular school morning drop-off is between 8:30 am – 9:15 am only. Students may not be permitted in school after 9:15 am. Students should be brought to school on time.

The drop-off time for students enrolled in the Before-School program is 7:30 am – 8:30 am.

Pick-up / Departure Procedures

Regular school Pick-up time is 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm.

Pick-up time for students enrolled in the After-School program is 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm.

Students should be picked up from outside the school building. Parents should ring the doorbell and wait for a staff member to assist you. **Parents may be asked to show a government issued I.D.**
